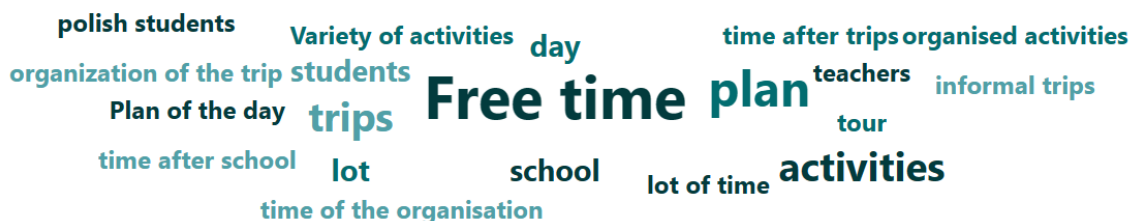


Evaluation

- I liked everything. I truly love this project.

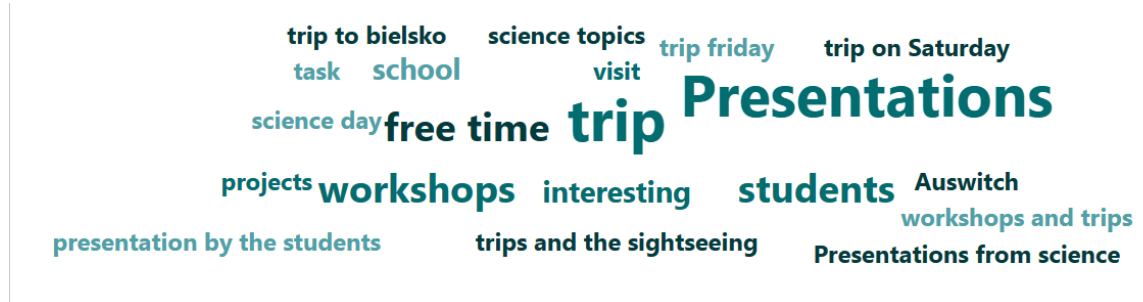


In terms of organisation what you liked least
